<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>How does the ear work? <i>Use the bottom link below</i></p> <p>Find out about what happens after sound waves enter the ear. Produce a model to show the parts of the ear. This can be Lego, Card, Clay.... Even Cake!</p>	<p><u>Geography/History</u></p> <p>Lighthouses (see question sheet)</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>The Running Bee Foundation Dr. Ron Hill Challenge.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Think about your Science task last week, how sounds are made. Using a ruler or flexible piece of material, ping it against a table.</p> <p>When the ruler is long, it makes a low sound. When short a high sound. This is the <u>PITCH</u> of the note - but why does this happen?</p> <p>List as many instruments as you can that work on this idea.</p>
