**Nursery activity ideas**

Plant Growth

Nursery will know that a seed needs soil, water and sunlight to grow.  
 Nursery will know some of the foods we eat that come from plants  
 Nursery will know that plants grow from a seed  
 Nursery will be able to name the parts of their bean plant

Human Growth/healthy eating

Nursery will know the following vegetables – peas, carrots, broccoli, cauliflower, potatoes  
 Nursery will know the following fruits – apple, orange, banana, strawberries, raspberry  
 Nursery will know that some foods we should eat every day and some foods we should only eat occasionally  
 Nursery will know that we have to have a balanced diet to grow strong and healthy and eating different foods is good for you.

Animal Growth

Nursery will know the adult and baby names of animals; Sheep/lamb, cow/calf, chicken/chick, pig/piglet, horse/foal.  
 Nursery will know that some of our foods come from animals.

Nursery will know that people who work on a farm are called farmers.

Life Cycle of a Frog

Nursery will know the words frogspawn/eggs, tadpole, froglet and frog.

Nursery will know the features of a tadpole, froglet and frog.
